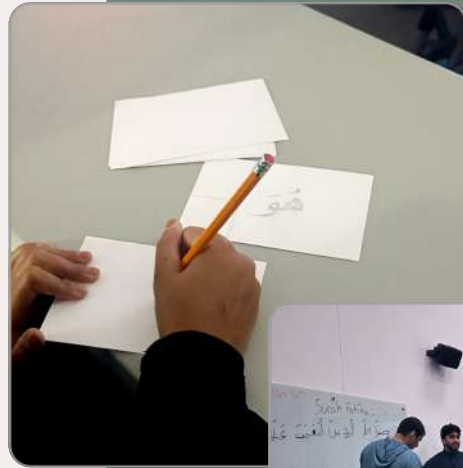
## Quran Academy
